THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM
ACCORD FINANCIER ENTRE LE GOUVERNEMENT DU CANADA ET
LE GOUVERNEMENT DU ROYAUME-UNI

The Government of Canada and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland agree that the interest-free loan of £10 million to the Government of the United Kingdom under the War Loan Act, 1940, and the other arrangements made in respect of the loan will be continued until 1954, and that the other arrangements made in respect of the loan will be continued until 1954. The two Governments agree to enter into discussions before January 1, 1954 with respect to the question of interest, and the terms of repayment of the loan, and to sign an agreement in this regard when the two Governments have agreed the terms of such an agreement.
