		“6.1(1) Where the Minister of Industry, Trade and Commerce notifies the Minister of National Revenue that he requires copies of invoices of goods imported into Canada or of other customs documents relating thereto for the purpose of carrying out his duties under section 5, the Minister of National Revenue may, notwithstanding <u>section 67 of the Customs Act</u> , make such copies available to the Minister of Industry, Trade and Commerce or to persons employed in the Department of Industry, Trade and Commerce who have been designated by the Minister of Industry, Trade and Commerce for the purposes of this section and who have taken and subscribed an oath or affirmation pursuant to subsection (2).”
