5. The Committee of Deans shall hear and determine all cases referred to it by a Dean or Faculty and all appeals taken from the decisions of a Faculty. The Committee of Deans may impose such penalty as it may deem suitable and its decision shall be final and without appeal unless such penalty be expulsion, suspension for a period of more than one year and /or a fine exceeding \$100.00 in which case an appeal shall lie to Corporation. Notice of appeal must be given in writing to the Registrar of the University within thirty days of the sending of the decision of the said Committee to the student by registered letter addressed to him at his address as contained in the University records.

 - i. The accused shall be given at least three clear days notice in writing of the date, time and place of hearing of all trials and appeals before the Faculty, the Committee of Deans and Corporation.
 - ii. In the case of trials he shall at the same time be furnished with a statement of the offence or offences with which he is charged in sufficient detail to enable him to prepare his defence. He shall have the right to be heard, to produce and cross-examine witnesses and to
