directing the present Trustees, if she should desire it, to execute a release of the equity of redemption in the property to the Petitioner.

It was moved by Dr. Campbell, Clerk, and duly seconded, that the Assembly receive and adopt the report, and pass the resolution recommended by the Committee, "authorizing and directing the present Trustees, if she should desire it, to execute a release of the equity of redemption in the property to the Petitioner."

The motion was adopted.

It was afterwards moved by Principal Grant, seconded by Dr. Black :

That the Presbytery of Hamilton is recommended, in view of all the circumstances, and ex-gratia, to appeal to those members of the Church whose sympathies are enlisted in Mrs. Webber's case, for contributions to ensure her suffering no loss, and to ask the assistance specially of the Presbytery of Paris in the matter.

It was moved in amendment by Dr. Campbell, seconded by Mr. J. D. McGregor: That the members of Assembly who sympathize with Mrs. Webber in her situation,

he allowed an opportunity of affording her relief.

A vote being taken, the motion was carried.
