thirty miles. There are five stations in this distance.

There are four small towns, namely: Wilmer, Athalmer, Invermere and Windermere, with churches, schools, hotels, stores and other conveniences. There is a good telephone system between Golden and Windermere, and most of the farms are on the line.

On account of its natural beauty the District is already favorably known to tourists, which will be further materially developed in the near future by the completion of the Banff-Windermere Motor Road. A trunk roal runs right through the Windermere District between Golden and Crunbrook; from this there are many lateral roads already built extending u<sub>1</sub> the various rivers and creeks already mentioned. All are good motor reads.

The warm waters of Lake Windernere are peculiarly atractive for lathing and boating. There is ex-
