THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL SD-12.

An Act for the relief of Norma Catherine Shearly McMullan.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Norma Catherine Shearly McMullan, residing at the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, wife of Albert Reginald McMullan, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the said city, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the eleventh day of June, A.D. 1955, at the city of Outremont, in the said province, she then being Norma Catherine Shearly; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, on the ground of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved 10 by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

1. The said marriage is hereby dissolved, and shall 15 be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.
