of one unhappy female Savage, and produce by fuch repeated Violence an infectious matter in the genital Parts of the polutted Victim; which by communicating itself to the Ravishers in some measure punished their crime.

THE last opinion seems most probable, as in later times the same cause has produced a Gonorrhea when it was proved that neither the woman nor any of the men labored under the Disease before.—
There are two species of the Venereal Disease, the simple Gonorrhea or Clap and the confirmed Lues or Pox—both contracted by Coition with an Insected Person.

THE first is Local proceeding sometimes from an Ulcer in the Urethra, so netimes from a diseased Relaxation of the Glandular Parts, and attended with a discharge, mucous, purulent, or Bloody, this is generally cured by cooling Purges combined with Duiretics, and often by Topical applications alone, injected into the Urethra.

THE other is a general Infection of the Mass of Blood, producing sometimes Ulcers and Excercences in the genital Parts, sometimes in the Throat, and frepuently in both, with pains in the Lmibs, &c. when these symptoms are perceived the Patient is said to be afflicted with a confirmed Lues or Pox—for this State of the Disease, Mercury is a general specific administered in various Doles, and Forms, proportioned to the age, strength, and constitution of the Patient; and to the Virulence and Duration of the Disease.

THE Ulcerations in the Throat are alike inci-
