

it consist of one or more volumes, without receiving the remaining volumes of any such work, consisting of more than one volume.

XVI.

The Chief Justice and the Justices of the said Courts, who are or may become Members of this Corporation, shall enjoy the privilege of conveying into their chamber, in the said Court-House, such books as they may require, to be returned within the Library hours of the same day on which they may be withdrawn.

XVII.

None of the fines and penalties imposed by the foregoing Sections of this Statute or Bye-Law shall be held forfeited and payable until it shall be so resolved and adjudged, at a general meeting of the Corporation, due notice, of two days at least, having been previously given by the Secretary, to the delinquent Member, of the subject of accusation to be brought against him at such general meeting.
