



No announcement relative to the work to be undertaken at the North Dome by the new management has been made, but it is said unofficially that the swamp to the south and north of the ridge of rock, where the old company sunk a shaft and did core drilling, are to be tested out with drills.

drilling, are to be tested out with drills. A small ridge of Keewatin and con-glomerate with slate showings passes thru near the centre of the three claims on a north-east and south-west strike, with the main five-foot vein running almost east and west thru this ridge. It is across the surface of this vein where the free gold showings came in sulphides. Thiling to depth to test out the val-ues was done, but no public announce-ment has been made as to the results. It was on this property that the lives of over 200 men, women and children were saved during the July 1 fire. The deep swamp to the south caused the flames to slow up and turn slightly to the east across the Dome Extension ridge. The force of the heat was somewhat broken. Camp buildings sufficient to accom-modate 40 men and an office force are up. Former Manager Chris Nelson lost no time in resuming work shortly after the fire and that work has been continued steadily to the present time. One shaft is down on the ridge, and a half dozen drill holes have been made.




