INCOME RETURNS CITY OF TORONTO

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto passed, on December 6th, 1920, Bylaw No. 8584, which is as follows: 1, 1920, Bylaw No. 8684, which is as follows:

"Every person in receipt of an income liable to assessment shall, between the 15th and 25th days of February in each year, forward to the Assessment Commissioner of the City of Toronto, a statutory declaration according to the form referred to in Sub-section 1A of Section 18 of the Assessment Act, showing his total income from all sources during the current year, and in ascertaining such income, Sub-section 2 of Section 11 of the said Act shall apply, provided, however, that this Bylaw shall not apply to persons who have made a return to the Assessor upon request, as provided by Section 18 of the Assessment Act."
