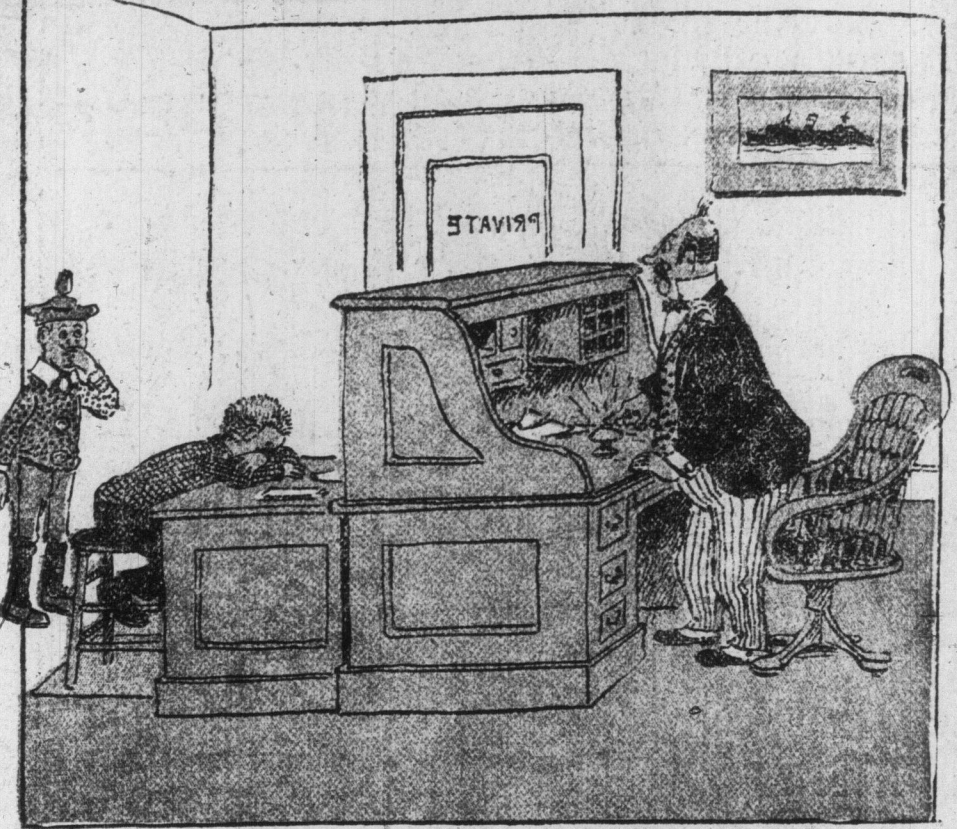
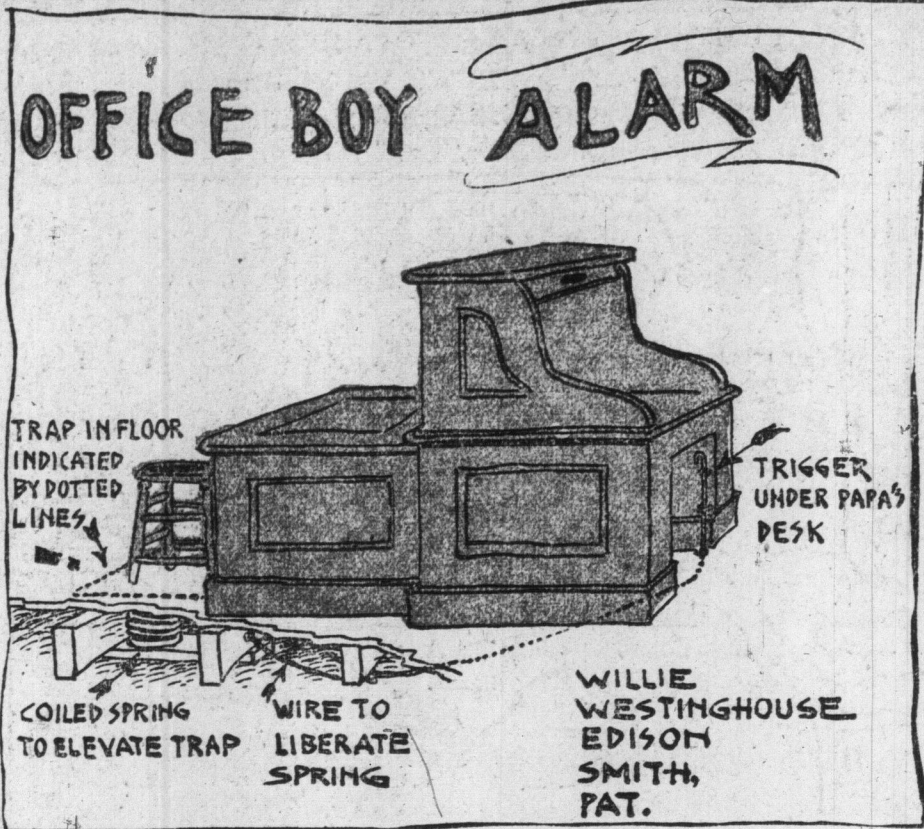
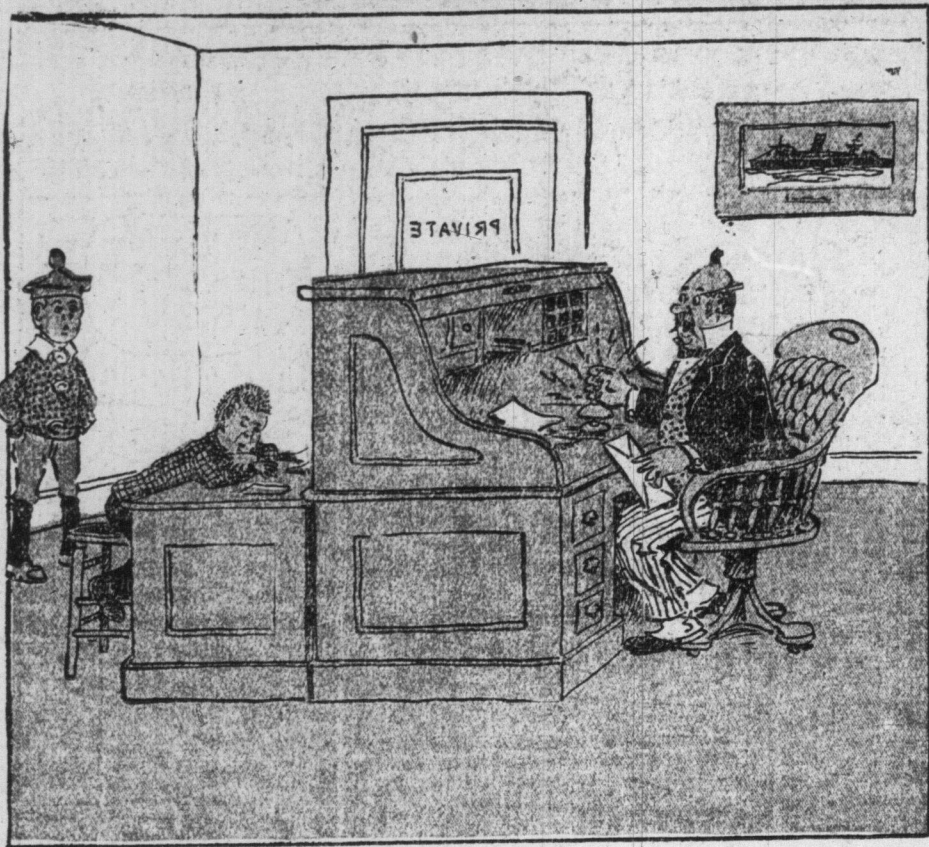
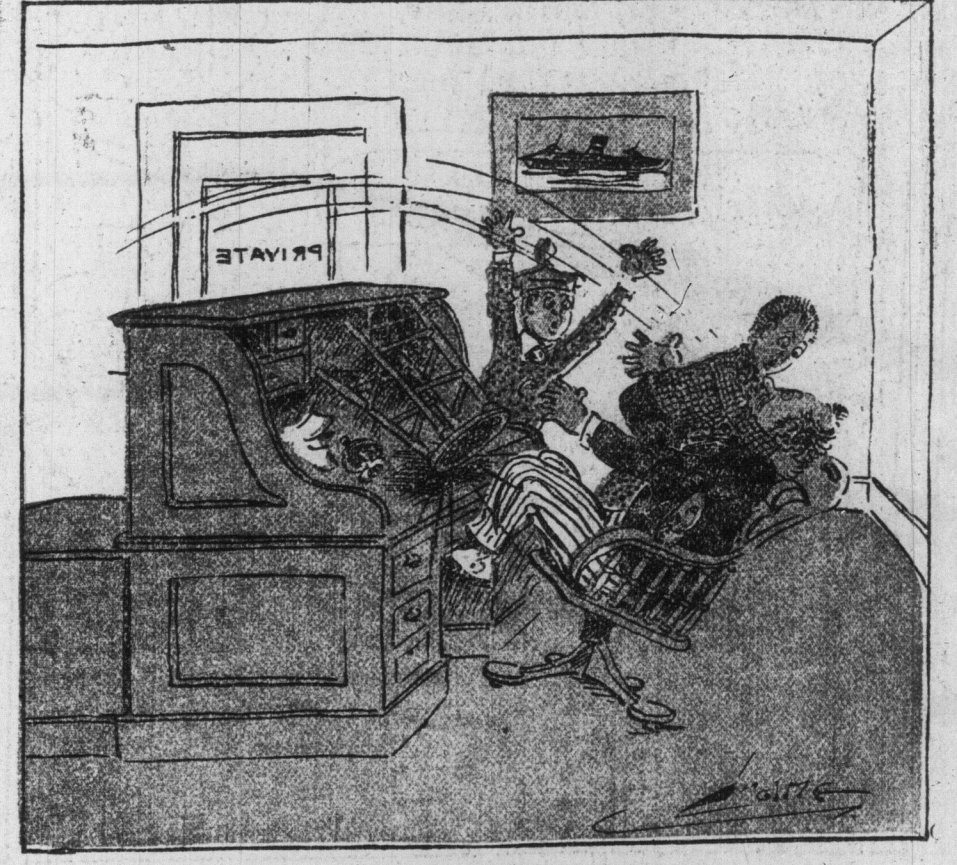
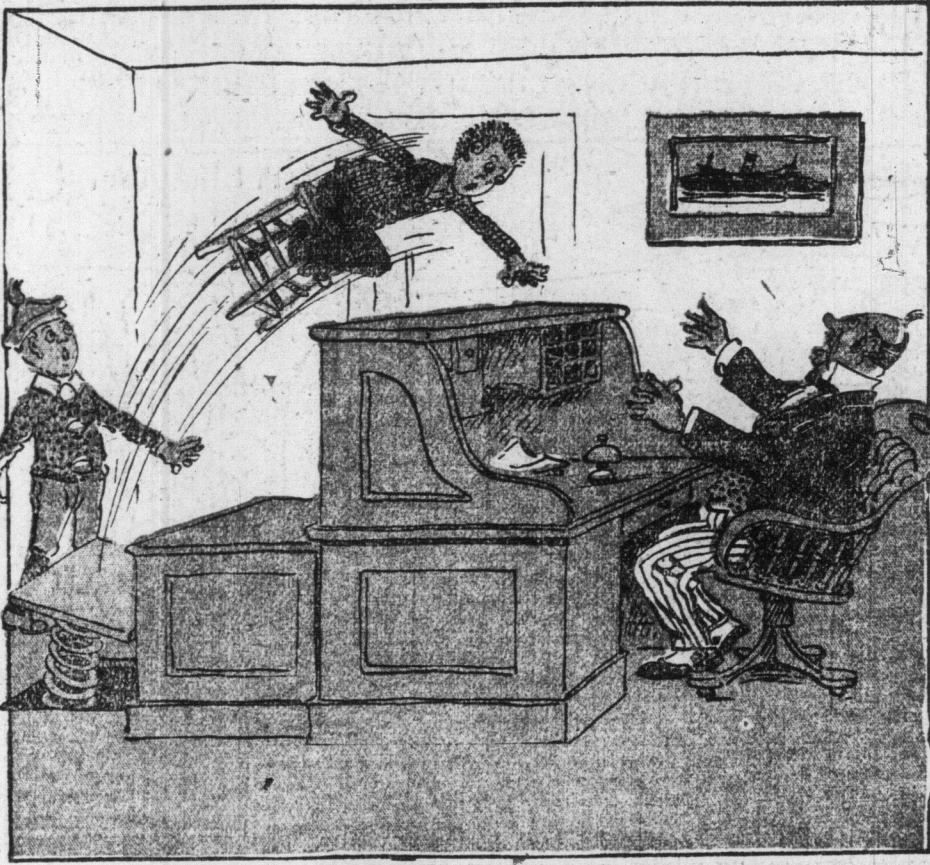
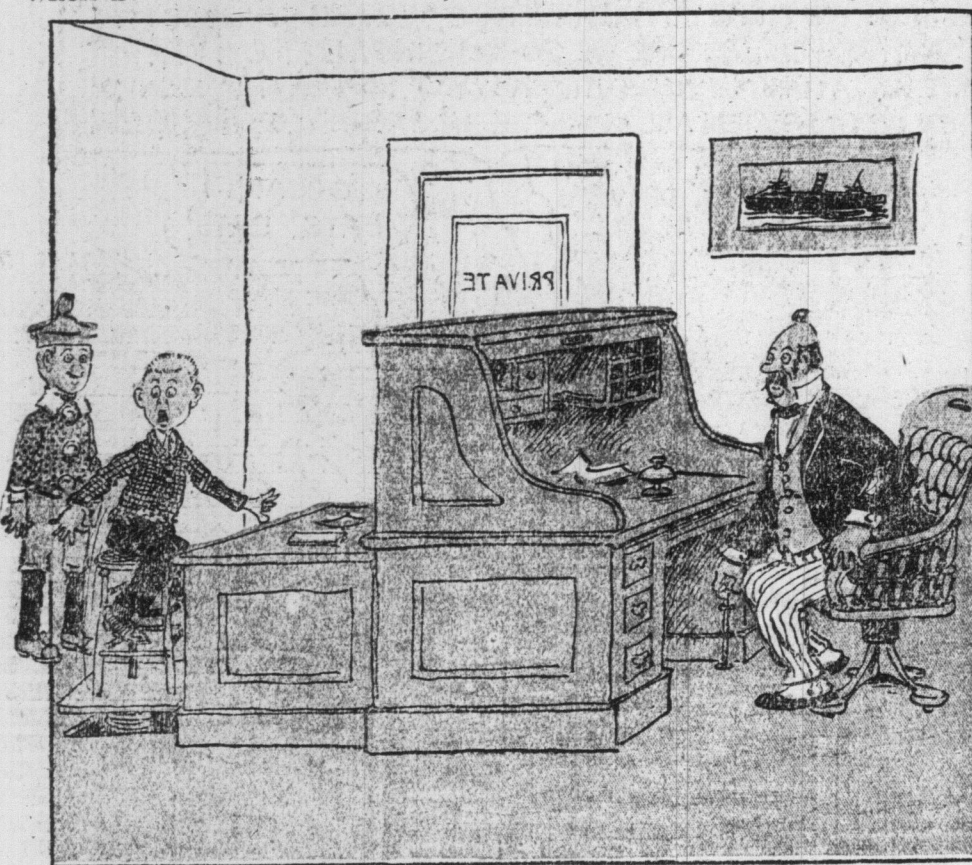


# WILLIE'S CATAPULT KNOCKS THE WIND OUT OF PAPA
