

MINUTES OF CONFERENCE

TAKEN IN THE

WELLINGTON STREET CHURCH, BRANTFORD, ONTARIO.

Organization of the Conference, 2nd June, 1875.

THE SECOND ANNUAL LONDON CONFERENCE of the Methodist Church of Canada, began in the Wellington Street Church, in the Town of Brantford, at 9 o'clock a.m., on WEDNESDAY, the 2nd of June, 1875.

The Rev. JOHN A. WILLIAMS, President of the Conference, in the Chair.

The PRESIDENT read the 62nd Psalm and the 2nd Chapter of 2nd Timothy, and gave out the 478th Hymn.

The Revs. DR. FOWLER and WILLIAM WILLIAMS led in prayer.

The roll was called by the Rev. JAS. GRAY, the Secretary of the Conference, and One Hundred and Sixty-Eight answered to their names.

The Rev. JOHN A. WILLIAMS was re-elected President.

The Rev. WILLIAM WILLIAMS was elected Secretary.

The PRESIDENT and the SECRETARY each briefly addressed the Conference.
