GREATER PART OF GAGE ESTATE GIVEN CHARITIES

The late Sir William Gage, merchant, philanthropist of Toronto left an estate valued at \$500,000. FIERCE FIGHTING DURING WEEK END

Ireland Scene of Several Attacks on Saturday and Sunday—Priest and Bridegroom Slain.

Belfast, May 15—Miss Barrington, only daughter of Sir Charles Barrington, of Glenstal Castle, County Limerick, and head of the Masonic Order in North Munster, and Police Inspector Biggs were shot dead from ambush Saturday night by civilians while motoring from Killinacally to Newport, County Tipperary.

The father of the dead woman is a former high sheriff of County Limerick. Nine policemen, two soldiers and other persons were killed on Saturday and Sunday in attacks and counter attacks at various places. Numerous persons were wounded.

Constable Bridges was shot dead and two other constables were wounded while purchasing groceries, Saturday, at Drumcolougher. A party of police going to their relief was fired upon and two of the policemen were wounded slightly.

Fierce fighting followed an attack on Brandon police barracks. The streets were swept with machine gun fire and civilians were obliged to throw themselves on their faces in the street for safety. One hundred civilians attacked the Clonsilla barracks with rifles and machine guns on Saturday afternoon.

The attack was repulsed and fourteen of the attacking party were seen to fall. Unsuccessful attacks were made on Saturday night on the Rosslare pier barracks, County Wexford, the Bridgetown barracks, Wexford, the Spital barracks in Galway and the Holy Cross barracks in Tipperary.

Three riots occurred in Belfast yesterday. Many were injured but no lives were lost. In Dublin on Friday evening Sir Hamar Greenwood's car was fired on. He was not in the car at the time, but the driver narrowly escaped death.

On Saturday night the home of the Sinn Fein member of parliament, Liam Rotelle, was raided. The owners were absent, but a priest, Father O'Callaghan, who was in the house, was shot and killed. Patrick Sheehan, a republican, who was recently married, was shot through the heart while in his bedroom.

A short musical programme was enjoyed, those taking part being Mrs. Bell, Mrs. Harrison and Miss Ethel McKinley. The convenor for the entertainment were Miss Grace Etey, Miss Annie Hipwell, Miss Burnham, Miss Lordy, Mrs. Charles Bearborn, Mrs. George Lively and Miss Anderson.

TWO ARE DROWNED AS CAR OVERTURNS

Double Tragedy Near Walkerville Takes Man and Wife.

Walkerville, May 16—The police are investigating a double auto tragedy which occurred on the river front, a mile east of Walkerville, when a Packard touring car, believed to have been driven by Lewis A. Koch of Detroit, got beyond control and, leaving the narrow roadway, plunged down a 20-foot embankment into the Detroit River. Both Koch and a woman who was with him were drowned.

The spot where the accident occurred is rather lonely and it was nearly an hour before the Ford police learned of it. The car was found in about eight feet of water. It was overturned and the bodies of the two victims are believed to be pinned to the river bottom. Efforts to raise the auto were unsuccessful up to 10 o'clock.

THE VALERIAN H. M. S. Valerian, commanded by Captain Hugh S. England, which arrived in port on Saturday afternoon, was crowded with visitors all day yesterday. The members of the crew were very courteous and obliging in explaining the mechanism of the guns and the working of the varied equipment. The Valerian is docked at the Pettibone Wharf and since leaving Plymouth, Eng., in January has covered 6200 sea miles. She will sail from here either on Tuesday afternoon or Wednesday morning for Digby, then to Halifax, through the straits of Canso and through the straits of Northumberland around to Quebec. On her return she will touch at Newfoundland and Sydney and then back to Bermuda.

The Valerian was built in 1913 and was used as a mine-sweeper in the war later being converted into a light cruiser. She is equipped with two four-inch guns, two two-pounders and three three-pounders.

On Sunday headed by St. Mary's Band the officers and crew paraded to St. John's (Stone) church to attend the morning service. Mayor Schmidt, Commissioners Jones, Frink and Thornton, and R. B. Armstrong, president of the Navy League, marched with the sailors.
