Morning Stock Letter

NEW YORK, April 13.—With talk of
an inflation arising in the commodity
market and the stock market dispirited
by the reaction of the last six weeks,
business seems to be in a position where
it can proceed with expansion. Despite
reaction in wheat prices from the high,
prices are still 10 per cent. above where
they were in the middle of 1924. The
farmer in the middle west is probably
beginning to feel a period of prosperity.
Happily, the reaction in wheat prices
is not universal. In the next several months,
without any indications of a boom, the
future in this country seems bright. For
several weeks the stock market has in-
dicated that liquidation has been almost
completed and that the technical posi-
tion is not weak. It is likely profes-
sionals will try to drive the market in
direction of bringing lower prices. Would
not be surprised if such a drive were
launched today. Believe, however, that
whenever stocks sell off slightly they can
be bought for higher prices later on.
Because of the small attendance in Wall
Street Saturday the reaction of steel
prices is not so great as it was. If steel
can be bought, M. P. and L. V. are
acting much better, and we think they
will sell higher. Texas Pacific should
be bought whenever it sells below 50.

tion 51,480 tons.

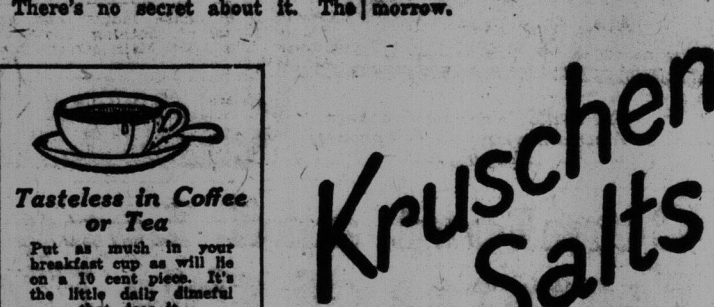

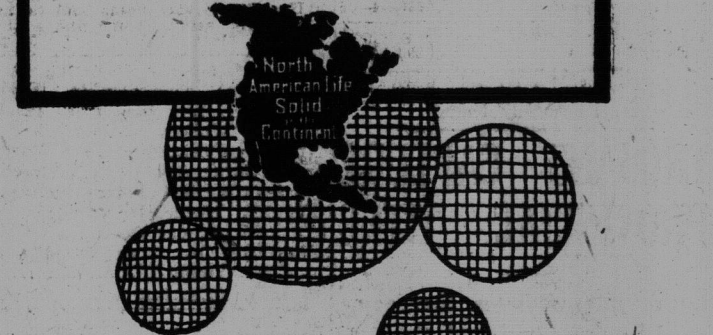
