NEW YORK, April 14—With talk of an inflation arising in the commodity market and the stock market dispelled by the reaction of the last six weeks, business seems to be in a position where it can proceed with expansion. Despite reaction in wheat prices from the high prices are still 50 per cent. above where they were in the middle of 1924. The farmer in the middle west is probably just starting on a period of prosperity. Hist buying is bound to be felt in other markets in the next several months. Without any indications of a boom, the future in this country seems bright. For several weeks the stock market has indicated that liquidation has been almost completed and that the technical position is not weak. It is likely professionals will try drives at the market in hopes of bringing lower prices. Would not be surprised if such a drive were launched today. Believe, however, that whenever stocks sell off slightly they can be bought for higher prices later on Because of the small attendance in Wall Street Saturday the reflection of steel's unfilled tonnage statement may be felt to a greater extent today. If steel sells off, believe U. S. Steel, Sloss and GST. can be bought. MP. Pfd and LV. are acting much better and we think they will sell higher. Texas Pacific should be bought whenever it sells below 50.






