Sir,

Adverting to Despatch 209 210 of the 20th January last, from your Department, transmitting, for the information of my Government, copy of an approved Minute of Council directing that the attention of my Government be invited to the circumstances therein set forth in connection with the reported actions of one Louis, an Indian, who has been employed as a Constable by the Stipendiary Magistrate on the Upper Skeena, I have now the honour to transmit, herewith, copy of a Report of a Committee of my Executive Council approved by me on the 15th instant, submitting a report from Captain Fitzstubs, Stipendiary Magistrate at Hazelton, Skeena River, accompanied by a letter from the Anglican Missionary, Mr. Field, and letters from Louis, the Indian referred to, and other Indians.
