The Tercentenary of Blessed Peter Canisius



HREE hundred years ago there died at Friburg, Switzerland, an eminent man and great saint, the Blessed Peter Canisius, on whom the Holy See has bestowed the glorious title of Apostle of Germany.

Scarcely had he breathed his last when with one voice bishops, priests and laymen,

who had been witnesses of his work, loudly proclaimed that if their fatherland were then not totally perverted by heresy it was owing to his tireless zeal.

During his long career, Canisius, the missionary, the preacher, the contraversialist, the writer, the counsellor of kings, of bishops and of ipopes, the founder of colleges and of universities, and above all the priest eminently holy, had struggled perseveringly against the rising flood of Lutheranism and had forced it back.
