**Personal best key to Citi Swim**

Approximately 700 swimmers began training Monday, in preparation for the fifth annual Mississauga Citi Swim season.

The program provides non-elite competition to recreational swimmers at a reasonable cost. The Personal-Best-System of scoring, whereby a swimmer scores points by improving on his or her personal best time from week to week, will again be used this year but in a different format.

Fees are \$15 for a summer, \$11.50 for a month and \$3 for a week. The price includes three one-hour practices weekly, a meet every Saturday morning and two championship meets over the course of the summer.
