The Inspector of Indian Agencies Reserves for Man. and Recevation Kas informed the Dept. that parties to whom patents have been issued, for land within the Indian Reserve at H. Veters claim the right to have intoxicating ligures in their possession on their lats and that to Enterfere with them so long as they do not deal it out to the Indians. Mr.M.Coll states that if the position in the matter taken by these farties is valid, it is evident that they can easily sell intoxicating lignors to irresponsible Halpbruks, who in turn will dispose of the same to the Indiand, and the Dept.
