Memorandum

Mr.McInnes, -

An Order in Council is required transferring to the Crown as represented by the Province of Saskatchewan, a right of way for a surveyed road, containing 2,64 acres, through the S.E. Sec. 5, Tp. 19, R. 5, W. 2. M. being part of the Kakewistahaw Indian reserve No. Zenthe said right of way being shown on plan of survey made by K.N. Crowther, D.L.S., dated 14th December 1922, a copy of which is recorded in the Surveys Branch of the Department of Indian Affairs under number Rd. 2056.

The said right of way replaces and for the greater part coincides with a roadway previously reserved by the Department for the Province. This latter roadway is shown on plan of survey by W.T. Thompson, D.L.S., dated 7th April 1905, a copy of which is recorded in the Surveys Branch of the Department of Indian Affairs under No.713. As the Province relinquishes all claim to the last mentioned roadway, it is considered the transfer may be made without compensation.
