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TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Act and Regulations passed thereunder for the disposal of Petroleum and Natural Gas rights on Indian Reserves, and to the terms and conditions of a certain permit dated the 15th day of April, A.D. 1947, made between His Majesty, King George the Sixth, represented by the Minister of Mines and Resources of the first part, and yourself of the second part, covering that tract of land containing 5,120 acres more or less and described as Sections 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20, in Township 27, Range 4, West of the 9th Meridian, and by reason of your failure to observe the provisions of Section 2 of the said regulations, it is the intention to cancel your permit on the 5th day of January, 1948, next.
