This Department has under consideration an application from The Bridge River Power Company, Limited, under Section 7, Chapter 115, Revised Statutes of Canada, 1906 - the Navigable Waters Protection Act - for the approval of an Electric Generating Station proposed to be erected for the utilization of 3,000 cubic feet per second of water from the Bridge River and discharging such water into Seton Lake, in the Province of British Columbia.

Encl. I send you, herewith, for your information, a copy of the plan and description of the site of the work as submitted by the applicant company.

An affidavit by the Assistant Solicitor of the said Company has been filed with this Department to the following effect:-

"That the said Bridge River Power Company, Limited, is the owner of 125.71 acres more or less comprising Blocks "A", "B" and "C" in the Slesh or Shalalth Indian Reserve No. 1 in the District of Lillooet.

That the said Bridge River Power Company, Limited, has acquired a Crown Grant of the said land more particularly described therein, dated the 26th day of January, 1926, reference No. 20612, sale No. 6, and recorded in the Department of Indian Affairs, on the 23rd day of February, 1926, Liber No. 54, Folio No. 72."

Will you please say whether your Department has granted the land mentioned in the affidavit and whether the same covers the site of the proposed work?
