can, by guaranteeing the S.G.Ds. guarantees, secure in addition to other great advantages, direct and indirect, the exercise of a natural preference for British over Foreign produce in our home markets, and an increase of price to the Dominion grower on his export, they will not be able to withstand the pressure of public opinion which will demand that, red tape or no red tape, this thing shall be done.

No principle of Free Trade stands in the way, and the liability is practically nil. Please send this letter to the Duke of Norfolk, and the Board.
