I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant, reporting with reference to the Lottéridge matterin regard to which the Department wrote you on the 27th May; and in reply I have to request that you will inform Lottridge that if he has any receipts to produce for payments which he made to the late Mr Cameron in connection with the liquor fines he must produce them at once :otherwise the Department will accept the amount \$25.00, which Mr Leonard is willing to pay on behalf of the Cameron Estate, and Lottridge will be held by the Department responsible for the balance.
