This refers to your memorandum of May 16, 1963, with which you returned the above noted voucher.

I have discussed this matter with the Pacific Western Airlines Base Manager at Norman Wells who submitted the original tender. He advised me that while the tender stated that meals and accomodation would not be provided the \$1400.00 tendered did, in fact, include meals and accomodation for the crew. The account submitted is lower than the original tender, although the trip was not made from Fort McPherson to Old Crow.

I might point out that under Pacific Western Airlines tariffs, meals and accomodation must be provided for the crew if the aircraft is chartered for a longer period than 24 hours. I was in error therefore, when I made up the tender form.
