

These supplies are to be delivered at the various points at the prices quoted, except the tea which is to be advanced in price by one cent at each point. Your obedient servant,

It is desired that you should inspect these supplies at Prince Albert before being shipped. A sample of the flour being shipped should be forwarded to the Department for comparison with the standard tendered on, and if found inferior a reduction in price will be made.

In submitting your report of inspection, you will please furnish the Department with a list of the dates of delivery.
