



SIR,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 6th instant, with inclosed copy of resolution passed by the Council of the band of Manitoulin Island, unceded part, asking for permission for Michel Wakegijig to cut sufficient pine for the erection of a barn 60 x 40 feet with addition of shed 60 x 12 feet, and in reply to inform you that a permit may be given to the applicant to cut sufficient timber on the reserve for the purpose, but you should see that no more is cut than is actually needed and that none of it is otherwise disposed of.
