Lease to James C. Shields subsequently transferred to Smith Curtis. Files I4240I and II0658

A tract at the Southerly end of the Deadman's Creek Reserve, B.C. containing 4926 acres for 50 years at \$500.00 per annum. To spend \$25,000.00 in irrigation work. The small tract at the Deadman's Creek reserved for the Indians for fishing. Not to decrease the water supply in Deadman's Creek to a less amount than is necessary for the purposes of supplying water on the lands of the said reservation now or in future under cultivation and not herein described. Indians to be compensated for damage. Plan of record in the Survey branch and blue print copy attached to the lease.
