- A. I saw the body lying on the sidewalk about fifty feet from the vehicle.
- Q. What time did you arrive at that spot?
- A. Approximately 0055 hours.
- Q. I am going to ask you to draw a sketch of the matters referred to in your evidence. Will you draw the things as I ask you questions?
- A. Yes
- Q. Will you first of all draw an arrow on the sheet whowing the NORTH direction.

(witness draws)

Next of all will you draw two lines representing the curbs of Avenue Brugmann at the scene of the accident?
(witness draws)

- Q. What was the width of the street there?
- A. Approximately thirty feet.
- Q. Will you mark that in from curb to curb? (witness draws)
- Q. Now will you please draw in the EAST and WEST sidewalks? What was the width of the sidewalk, approximately?
- A. Ten feet, sir (witness draws)
- Q. Will you mark in ten feet? As the width from curb to house.
 (witness draws)
- Q. Were there any tram lines in that street?
- A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Will you draw these in? (witness draws)
- Q. I see that the tram lines lie on the EAST side of the street and not in the centre. Is that correct?
- A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Willyou tell the Court what the pavement of the street consists
- A. Shingled verge, sir, about three feet, and the rest was small flage.
- Q. What about the road area itself?
- A. cobble stone, sir.
