Dear Sir:

I beg to forward herewith a letter from Mr. Indian Agent Ball recommending the sale of the remaining timber on Squamish I.R. #25 (Kaikalahun).

It would appear from Mr. Ball's letter that the Indians concerned agreed to the sale of this timber some years ago, and as the greater part of it has been logged off the value of the remainder is probably less than \$500.00 and advertising would not be necessary. Under these circumstances, the issue of the requisite permit to the Sorg Company of Port Mellon would appear to be in order.

The Department's decision at an early date in respect to this application would be appreciated.
