FAMILY PODICIPIDÆ. GREBES.

GENUS COLYMBUS.

SUBGENUS COLYMBUS.

1. Holbcell's Grebe.

(Colymbus holbælli)

A regular but never a common spring and autumn visitor to the waters of southern Ontario. Probably breeds in the northern part of the Province.

SURGENUS DYTES

2. Horned Grebe.

(Colymbus auritus.)

Abundant on the great lakes and all large bodies of water throughout the Province in spring and autumn, breeding in the large marshes. A few remain on Lake Ontario through the winter.

GENUS PODILYMBUS.

3. Pied-billed Grebe.

(Podilymbus podiceps.)

A common summer resident of marshes all over the Province, breeding throughout its range. Arrives early in April, departs about the middle of October.
