

HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

⁴ NY even-numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Backatchowan, and Alberta, ex-cepting 8 and 8, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any per-son who is the sole badd of a family, or any maje over 15 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 150 acres, more or legs.

or less Application for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Towninon Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district in which the land is situate. Entry by proxy, may, however, be made at any Agency on certain condi-tions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother, or sister of an intending homestender.

DUTIES - (1) At least six months' residence upon and cul-livation of the land in each year for three years.

(b) three years. (2) A homesiesder may, if he so desires, perform the required realdence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (20) acress in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. He may also do so by living with father or mother, on certain conditions. Joint owner-ehit in land will not meet this re-quirement. autrement.

(3) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with usrents or on farm-ing land owned by himself must notify the agent for the district of such intention.
