the fame in repair during the faid term, as well as the avenues thereto, on each fide of the faid river, or to make fuch regulations, in this behalf, as to the wifdom of the Houle may feem meet.

Mr. Lee moved, feconded by Mr. Gauvreau, that the faid Petition do lay on the table, for the confideration of the Members.

Mr Blanchet moved in amendment, feconded by Mr. Tafchereau, to leave out all the words after "that" and infert "the faid Petition be referred to a Committee of five Members, with power to fend for perfons and papers."

The House divided on the question of amendment.

Yeas 15 Nays 5

So it was carried in the affirmative.

The main question, as amended, was now put ; and it was agreed unto by the House.

RESOLVED, That the Petition of *Pierre Edouard Defbarats*, Efquire, be referred to a Committee of five Members, with power to fend for perfons and papers.

ORDERED, That Mr. Blanchet, Mr. Taschereau, Mr. Bruneau, Mr. Dénéchau, and Mr. Cuthbert, do compose the faid Committee.

Mr. Dénéchau, from the Committee of the whole House, to whom it was referred to confider the powers and authorities exercised by the Courts of Justice, in this Province, under the denomination of Rules of Practice, reported, according to order, the resolutions of the Committee.

And he read the report in his place, and afterwards delivered it in at the Clerk's table, where the refolutions were again read, and are as followeth, viz. RE-
