And that this House will make provision; in the next session, for supplying such money out of the public revenue.

Mr. Robert Pagan moved for an address to His Excel- Metion for an LENCY the Lieutenant Governor, which he read in his place and then delivered in at the Clerk's table—and the same being again read, was agreed to by the House—and is as follows, viz.

"The Humble ADDRESS of the House of Assembly.

May it please Your Excellency!

HE House of Assembly beg leave to represent that "the city of Saint John, the Town of Saint An-" drews, and the adjacent coasts of this province are exposed to " predatory attacks from Armed Vessels of the enemy, which, " if the war should continue, may prove very distressing to the " inhabitants by the loss of their trade and the destruction of "their habitations and property, which may be effected " before sufficient assistance can be sent to them as there are " no Ships of War belonging to. His MAJESTY cruifing in " the Bay of Fundy or stationed as Guard Ships in any of it's " ports, neither are there any Regular Troops at Saint An-"drews or any part of the county of Charlotte the most ex-" posed part of this province.

"The House of Assembly, having the fullest confidence in "Your Excellency's attention at all times to whatever "may promote the general fafety and prosperity of the pro-"vince, humbly hope Your Excellency will cause pro-" per representations to be made to the Officer commanding "HIS MAJESTY'S Ships of War on the North American "Station respecting a Naval Defence, which will also give " fecurity to that valuable part of the province of Nova-Scotia " bordering on the Bay of Fundy; and that such measures " may be taken for the protection of the inhabitants on the " frontiers of the province at large, and the further fecurity of " the city of Saint John as Your EXCELLENCY may in your " wisdom think meet."

The committee appointed to examine the accounts of the Report of a several persons who have been intrusted with the expenditure committee, of the public monies—made a report—which was read—and Ordered, To lie on the table.
