Lloyd George Is Defended In The Senate

Ottawa, April 21-Sharp cross-fir ing between Senators Beaubien, of contreal and Fowler, of Sussex, on the war achievements of Great Briin and France, respectively, and a glowing tribute to the statesmanship of Lloyd George from the latter mem ber of the upper chamber featured the afternoons session of the senate. Discussing a bill introduced by San ator Lynch Staunton, which seeks to

compel persons selling German-made ods to exhibit a sign to that effect utside their place of business, Sen ator Beaubion agreed with many other members that those responsib le for the great world war should be punished and made to feel the con sequences of their guilt, which at present they were not doing. He would have a resolution sent to the British house urging more sympathy

for France.
"Do I understand the honorable gen tlemen to charge Britain with lack of sympathy for France? queried Sen

ator Fowler. Senator Beaubien replied that he was dissappointed that when France protested against Germany sending oops into Ruhr district, Lloyd George had failed to say "we are by

"It is to be regretted that there is a certain type of mind in this cham ber which cannot make a speech without showing dislike for Great Britain, said Senator Fowler with in the war but where any one declar ed that she had done more than Eng land he, the speaker, must hurl such a falsehood back in their teeth. England had not only been bled white herself, but had it not been for the English borrowings in the United States on French account the pound sterling would be at par today. He said the gentleman who had just spoken never missed an opportunity get a stab at England.

Senapr Beaubien interrupted to say that he had not sneered at Eng-and but had criticized Lloyd George r the position referred to.

"Lloyd George is the greatest living statesman today," replied Senator Fowler. "If he had not stepped in it the crucial monient there was no telling what would have happened The change for the better in the Allied war fertunes was noticeable he very minute that he took over the rains of power." He added that be was accomplishing as great work now that peace had come as he did during the most critical period of
