"However, could you do that quickly enough?" I asked her after the first flurry had subsided.

"Because I had to," she answered, rather grimly, with a slight shudder for the danger passed.

And she was right. "Had to," was the occasion and the strength wrapped up in one package. If she had been asked to see how quickly she could move her hand across she could never have attained that speed, but along came the need and with it the ability.

Again and again, in the lives of most of us, necessity proves to be not only the mother of invention but of unguessed powers and capabilities.

"Chezar Vilyam's"
Amazing Doings.

Munchausen Out-Munchausened.

The Prussian-Turkish Alliance has resulted in the appearance of a kind of journalism that leaves David Crockett and Baron Munchausen out of sight in the rear, and almost fitted to take its place among the "Arabian Nights," if to its other attributes it would only add that of charm of style.

The conversion of the Kaiser to Mohammedanism is the centre of all the romance, for this is firmly believed by the ignorant Moslem masses in Constantinople and elsewhere. It is related that the Emperor—"Chezar Vilyam" in Turkish—was "converted" fifteen years ago, but for political reasons did not avow it until the Balkan assault on Turkey, when his conscience began to trouble him. Then he made his "confession of faith." One Turkish newspaper tells what followed:

Upon his confession of faith, the story runs, the entire army staff of the Great Chezar, became Moslem. This was followed by a wave of Moslem conversion throughout the two Teutonic empires. Upon this the rest of Europe attacked the newly converted Moslem empires in order to check the spread of Mohammedanism throughout the rest of Europe. Consequently, Germany and Austria are fighting the battles of the Moslem world.

The Asia Minor edition of another paper contains this wonderful "news": "The speech of his Moslem Majesty Chezar Vilyam the Second, delivered last week from the throne of the former House of the French Parliament, is a lasting credit to his wonderful record. There, surrounded by the vanquished, he offered his imperial right hand to all the former Deputies of the French House of Representatives, whose hearts were touched by his Moslem Majesty's magnanimity."

The above is matched by still another from the same source:

"According to a wireless from Amsterdam the British Government has offered 2,000 donkey loads of gold as indemnity if the mighty feet of His Moslem Majesty abandon its attack on London. This offer was refused by the Government of His Moslem Majesty the Chezar Vilyam the Second."

Such is the output of the German Ananias Bureau organized in Turkey, the entire press of that country being controlled by agents of the Kaiser.

And here is still another from Constantinople:

"On the first day of December twenty-five German balloons visited Adrianople and carried out the First Army Corps from this city with accoutrements. We trust that soldiers of Osmanli will administer a crushing defeat to the infidel Franks."

From the "Ladies' Journal" of the same city comes this startling announcement:

"The harem of his Moslem Majesty, Chezar Vilyam the Second, together with the harems of his staff officers, will visit Constantinople early next spring. Ten of the most powerful of the captured British dreadnoughts will escort the imperial party."

Another paper tells of the massacre of 500,000 Moslem Indians in South Africa. From an Asia Minor publication the public learns the following:

"According to a wireless received by the Germanic News Bureau from the capital of Belgium, the entire population of that newly conquered German territory have declared their loyalty to His Moslem Majesty. The Belgian people of all classes are flocking by thousands to the German officials and confessing the true Islamic faith. The Belgian people are voluntarily converting their churches into Islamic houses of worship. May their good examples be followed by the other infidels!"

The above is matched by still another from the same source:

"According to a wireless from Amsterdam the British Government has offered 2,000 donkey loads of gold as indemnity if the mighty feet of His Moslem Majesty abandon its attack on London. This offer was refused by the Government of His Moslem Majesty the Chezar Vilyam the Second."

THE RABBIT FENCE.

AUSTRALIA'S BARRIER IS 1,200
MILES LONG AND JEALOUSLY
GUARDED.

From Condon to Hopetown, clear across the continent of Australia runs a fence of woven wire 1,200 miles long, and the single purpose of its construction is to guard the fertile farm lands from the havoc-making rabbit pest. The entire eastern part of the continent is overrun with rabbits, but the western state, the "Golden State," as it is proudly called, is practically free from them, thanks to this seventh wonder of a fence. Upon the intactness of this barrier depends the prosperity of every farmer in Western Australia and it is guarded with the eagerness and the care that a beleaguered state takes to prevent a devastating army from passing its boundary.

Imported into the country by some immigrant, who doubtless hoped that they would live and thrive, the original party—for rabbits are not native to Australia—have multiplied into a countless horde, hardy, omnivorous and bold. In vast armies they scout

along the fence seeking for some entrance hole, and often travel hundreds of miles to one ocean end of the fence trying to find a place of passage through from the inhospitable regions to the fertile farms.

The most amazing precautions are taken by the "Golden State" to maintain the effectiveness of its barrier. Range riders guard it for its entire length and keep it in a perfect state of repair. Ingenious traps are installed at every railroad crossing, and wherever a road passes through, rabbit-proof gates are built into the fence. A heavy fine is the penalty for any one who leaves a gate open.

Sometimes a "willy-willy," or cyclone, levels whole sections of the fence, and then it must be rebuilt with all possible speed. Often this occurs in the desert country, through which a part of the fence runs, and then the posts and wire must be carried on camels from where the railroad ends. The expense of maintenance is large, but the saving to the fertile farms reaps the outlay many times in bountiful crops.

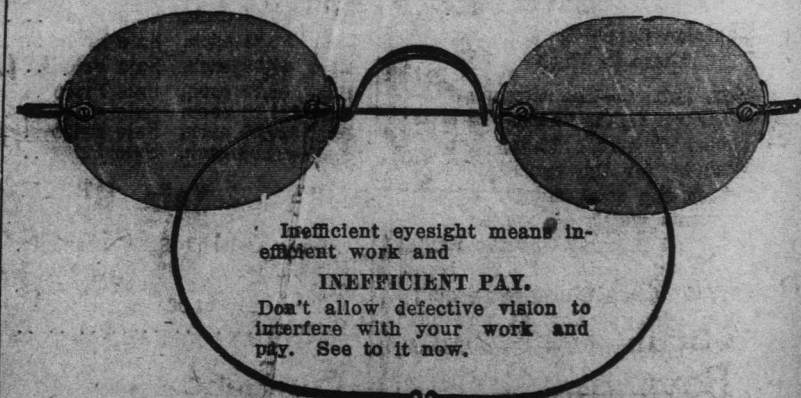
