The 1,000,000 war dead of France are to be transferred to permanent military cemeteries, or re-interred in private burial grounds, at the discretion of relatives.

Job D. Rockefeller, the great oil king, has recently announced a gift of \$3,763,257.37 in memory of his wife, for the benefit of charities and public institutions, chiefly or largely benefiting women and children. This gift is set apart for the support of the articular organizations which have supported Mrs. Rockefeller during her life time, and for other religious and philanthropic institutions of similar character.

Fifteen women are now regular ministers of the Gospel in the Methodist Church of the United States. The first lady of quality as a preacher was granted by the General Conference of the church last May.
