Sect. 2.—Each Subordinate Division shall submit a certified copy of all Bye-laws which they desire to adopt, to the examination of the Committee on Constitutions and Bye-laws, appointed as aforesaid by the Grand Division; and the said Bye-laws shall not be finally adopted by any Division unless the approbation of the said committee has been expressed in relation to the same.

6. The Committee on Credentials shall consist of three members, whose duty it shall be to examine and report on the regularity and sufficiency, or irregularity and insufficiency, of credentials of Representatives to this Grand Division.

7. The Printing Committee shall consist of three members, whose duty it shall be to superintend and contract for all printing the G. D. may order.

8. The Committee on Halls shall consist of one member for each district where sessions of G. D. may be appointed to be held during the ensuing year: each member of the committee shall, when needful, seek a suitable place for holding the meetings of the G. D., engage the same when directed, superintend the necessary preparations, and have the general oversight and charge of the room, with its furniture.

XI.

Every Subordinate Division shall pay to this Grand Division the sum of six cents per quarter for each member on the Financial Scribe's books.

XII.

No part of these Bye-laws shall be altered, repealed, or amended, nor any new Bye-law adopted, except at an annual meeting; nor then, unless notice in writing has been given at a preceding quarterly session.
