Friday, June 24, Micmac Day

6.30 a. m.—General Communion Mass

9 a. m.—Solemn Entry of His Lordship Bishop Blais of Rimouski. Opening of the Pastoral Visitation. Pontifical Mass. Sermon in Micmac by Father Pacifique and address by Chief Denny of Cape Breton.

3 p. m.—Vespers, Procession and Dedication of the Memorial Monument. Address by His Lordship, and then by several Indian Speakers. National Anthem. Return to the Church and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

7 p. m.—Friendly Meeting of the Chiefs, Captains and Councillors present, in the school-house, and visit to the Exhibition Hall.

Saturday, June 25

6 a. m.—Communion Mass celebrated by His Lordship.

9 a. m.—Solemn Service for all the departed members of the Tribe. Visit to the Burying Ground. Instruction for the occasion in Micmac.

3 p. m.—Blessing of the new school-house and visit of the Clergy to the Exhibition Hall.

Sunday, 26, Solemnity of

St. John the Baptist

6 a. m.—Mass by His Lordship.

7 a. m.—Communion Mass and Confirmation of Micmac Children.

9.30 a. m.—High Mass. Sermon in French. Procession to the Memorial Monument. Address in English. National Anthem. On returning "Te Deum" and Papal Blessing.

3 p. m.—Vespers, Benediction, Hymn to St. Ann and Veneration of Her Relics.

4 p. m.—Musical and Dramatic Entertainment, Readings, Addresses and songs in three languages.

Entrance, 25cts.; reserved seats, 50cts.

Remarks

1st—Friday and Sunday meals will be served to visitors in the old school-

house. At 12 o'clock on Friday a special table will be prepared for the Chiefs, Speakers and others.

2nd.—Between the Exercises people will be admitted to the Exhibition Hall

3rd.—New Medals of St. Anne de Ristigouche as well as Souvenir Badges and Post Cards of the Tercentenary will be at the disposal of visitors. Badges may be ordered from henceforth, but must not be worn before the 23rd inst. 10, 15, 20 and 25cents each.
