PART III

PROVISIONS CONCERNING BENEFITS

CHAPTER 1

TOTALIZING

Article VIII

- 1. If a person is not entitled to a benefit on the basis of the creditable periods under the legislation of one Party, eligibility for that benefit shall be determined by totalizing these periods and those specified in paragraphs 2 and 3 of this Article, provided that the periods do not overlap.
- 2. (a) For purposes of determining eligibility for a benefit under the Old Age Security Act of Canada, a period of residence in the territory of Cyprus, after the age at which periods of residence in Canada are creditable for purposes of that Act, shall be considered as a period of residence in the territory of Canada.
 - (b) For purposes of determining eligibility for a benefit under the Canada Pension Plan, a contribution year in which at least one fourth of the basic insurable earnings have been paid or credited under the legislation of Cyprus shall be considered as a year for which contributions have been made under the Canada Pension Plan.
- For purposes of determining eligibility for an old age pension under the legislation of Cyprus,
 - (i) a week ending on or before December 31, 1965 which is a creditable period under the Old Age Security Act of Canada shall be
