The Services Centre (SERV) offers a number of workshops and briefings to prepare employees and their families for upcoming postings. The workshops address the many issues and specific problems which may be encountered in the process of preparing employees and family members for assignments.

Administrative information, including the FSDs, mailing privileges and diplomatic and consular immunities and privileges are presented during the mandatory administrative briefings. A twoday briefing is offered to those leaving on a first posting and a one-day briefing for employees who have been on posting before.

Workshops cover the following themes: financial and legal, move-related, family oriented and spousal employment. A variety of other workshops such as protocol, first aid and CPR, staying healthy abroad and working with household staff are also offered.

Spouses and dependants have access to a variety of courses in getting ready to go abroad.

Specialized courses in the Trade and Political areas are offered to spouses through The Centre for International Affairs Learning and Management Development (CFSD) if space is available once employees have registered, if any pre-requisites for the training are met, and if the course is directly related to work which will likely be done on a posting or on returning to Ottawa.
