The better arrangements must be reached after full and free multilateral consultations, not by ultimatum and confrontation. The purpose of these consultations must be the further enlargement and liberalization of the terms of world trade, not its contraction, and they will only be successful if all the leading economic powers are determined to make them so. Canada will use every opportunity and every instrument at its disposal to get these consultations under way. We will work with the United States and our other partners to help make sure that they are both thorough and far-reaching, dealing effectively with the problems before us and laying a secure foundation for another generation of economic growth for developed and developing nations alike.
