### MCDOUGALL WELCOMES INTERNATIONAL **CANADIAN STUDIES EXPERTS**

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Barbara McDougall, today welcomed a group of foreign academics specializing in Canadian studies. be holding a series of meetings in Canada from May 29 to June 4, 1991.

"Foreign experts on Canada can act as a mirror for Canadians. They often reflect our country's values and importance in the world from a unique perspective," said Mrs. McDougall.

The Minister will host a luncheon for the group today. her address, Mrs. McDougall will speak on the fundamental importance of political stability and economic prosperity for Canada and the world.

The theme of the conference is "Global Restructuring: Canada in the 1990s."

ICCS is a learned society dedicated to promoting multidisciplinary Canadian studies abroad.
