PRAYERS

Mr. Smith (Saint-Jean), from the Standing Committee on Agriculture, presented the Second Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Wednesday, October 30, 1974, your Committee has considered Bill C-19, An Act to provide for payments in respect of wheat produced and sold in Canada for human consumption in Canada, and has agreed to report it with the following amendments:

Clause 2

Strike out line 9 on page 2 and substitute the following therefor:

"in the production of wheat or entitled to share in such production;"

Clause 5

Add immediately after line 47 on page 3, the following new subclause:

"(3) The Minister shall, on an annual basis and in consultation with the producers, review the provisions of this Act and all related regulations enacted by the Governor in Council with a view to making such recommendations to the Governor in Council as are appropriate in the light of prevailing costs of production of wheat and returns to producers."

Clause 10

Add immediately after the word "shall" in line 33 on page 5 the following words:

"for a period of six years or"

Your Committee has ordered a reprint of Bill C-19, as amended, for the use of the House of Commons at the report stage.

A copy of the Minutes of Proceedings and Evidence relating to this Bill (*Issues Nos. 4 to 17 inclusive*) is tabled.
