

Economically: Fogo Islanders are employed completely in relation to the fishery. Particularly in the winter months, this would allow the local population to be gainfully employed in their area of expertise "processing fish products".

Structurally: The fishermen and plant workers, as members, control the company. Operation costs and labour costs are controlled internally and can stimulate a more competitive product price wise.
