BANK ACT

MEASURE TO ENACT

The House resumed consideration of Bill C-19, an act respecting banks and banking, as reported (with amendments) from the Standing Committee on Finance.

The Acting Speaker (Mr. DeBlois): Pursuant to Standing Order 45(5)(a), the House will now proceed to the taking of the deferred divisions at the report stage of Bill C-19, an act respecting banks and banking.
