

continuously from the 22nd of June 1917.

These same Cadets (a large number of whom entered the Cadet School as privates, whereas I entered as a Sergeant) were paid sergeant's pay right up to the date of their discharge in Canada. In some cases this was many months after they had left the Cadet Schools. Whereas I have been allowed Sergeant's pay only up to the time of leaving the School.

At the present time as a patient under the S.C.R I am now drawing Sergeants pay and my discharge certificate dated November 25th 1919 shows I am entitled to Sergeants pay.

I will state that my wife has been receiving a \$20.00 allowance which should not be the case owing to my repeated and distinct objections to such.
