Resolved,—That the President do name a Committee of five to draft a memorial to the Parliament for aid to Victoria College, that Committee to Report at the opening session to-morrow morning.

REVISAL AND ALTERATION OF DISCIPLINE.

Moved by J. H MOORE, Esq.,-Seconded by J. MATHEWSON, Esq.,-

Resolved,—That this Committee recommends that the Conference appoint a Select Committee to revise the present Book of Discipline, so as to provide for the renting of Pews in our Churches, and otherwise to adapt it to the wants and requirements of Canadian Methodism.

Resolved,—That this Meeting recommend the Conferference to alter the first clause of answer first of the 5th section of the Discipline, and that every Circuit be required to furnish the house or houses of their married Preachers: and that, in order to enable Circuits to do this, an appropriation shall be made out of the amount reserved of the Contingent Fund for Extraordinaries, of such sum as the Contingent Fund Committee may think expedient.

Moved by REV. R. JONES-Seconded by T. Bickle Esq. :--

Resolved,—That Art. 2, sec. v. under the head of Temporal Economy, be erased from the Discipline.
