


was then added, leaving a white fimbriation or border to mark the original white field of the English flag.



UNION JACK, FROM 1707 TO 1801, A.D.

WHEN the union of Ireland took place in 1801 the Irish flag, consisting of a diagonal red cross, *St. Patrick*, on a white field, thus :—
