lihood of it's retrieving the smallest portion of it's former splendour, so long as those who now difgrace it, are suffered to continue there.

To remove from his Majefty's councils those Ministers, whole weakness or wickedness have tarnilhed the honour of his Crown, and whole measures have brought his dominions to their. prefent melancholy fituation; to remedy shole evils which their Administration hath given rife to, and by adopting a new fystem to reftore the national honour and public confidence, is the important task I wilh to impofe upon your Lordfhip. Arduous as it may appear, let us not deem it impracticable (for in that cale we are no longer a people). Your Principles, my Lord, I have no doubt, incline you to the general profperity : and when your Lordfhip confiders the prefent lituation of the country, you cannot, furely, refrain one moment from exerting those superior talents you possels, in order to complete the glorious work of Reforma-non , for i Γ I N. I S. House international.
